The Gandhi Fellowship (Piramal Foundation) Internship Program

Ms Nilima Sil, Country Manager (Gandhi Fellowship Program) is coming to the campus for conducting a talk on their 2-year fellowship program on **Friday, 29th January 2016 at 2 PM**. She is heading the all India marketing and recruitment of Gandhi Fellowship Program and will be addressing the students explaining their mission to create a pool of 1,000 passionate and entrepreneurial fellows.

The Gandhi Fellowship program is an initiative by Piramal Foundation and Kaivalya Education Foundation, rooted in the belief that as a nation it is important to develop a cadre of leaders exposed to the complexities of bringing change in social and public systems. The Gandhi Fellowship Program is designed to provide youth with the opportunity for personal transformation through self-discovery and thereby, contribute to the causes surrounding them. Since the inception of the fellowship, youngsters from engineering, applied and pure science, commerce and business, humanities and liberal arts, social and behavioural sciences, media and journalism, education, law, etc.

Roles and Responsibilities of a Gandhi Fellow-

- Each fellow plans, executes and transforms 5 schools.
- Fellows assist teachers and find when and where headmasters need extra support.

- The fellow potentially impacts the lives of 1,000 children.
- The fellow is responsible to improve the Student Learning Outcome (SLO) of the school.

Incentives-

- For the duration of the two years, the Fellows will be provided with a rent free accommodation, shared motor bikes, computers/tablets, internet facility and cook.
- A monthly grant of 600 ₹ will be provided to cover the cost of phone bill.
- Additionally a monthly stipend of 7,000 ₹ will be provided.
- Upon the completion of the Fellowship a seed capital of 1,61,000 ₹ will be provided by the organization to the Fellows.

Post-Fellowship Support-

- The Fellowship placement cell assist, if necessary, in finding jobs for the Fellows in the social change sector. The placements are in alignment with the Fellows dreams and passion.
