Important Points

1. The Form Filling Frequency is 100 forms per minute, so students must ensure their availability to fill the form as and when google form activated.
2. Students must check syllabus and pre-requisites of subjects to be opted. Link :- <https://www.du.ac.in/index.php?page=nep-ugcf-2022-syllabi>
3. Students **must not** choose same SEC, VAC Subjects as they studied in previous semesters.
4. Generic Elective Subjects **must not** same as their core department subjects. For Example: -
 - a. English (Hons.) Students must not choose GE of English Department
 - b. B.A.Prog.(English + Political Science) Students must not choose GE of English and Political Science
 - c. Science Programme Course Students must not choose GE of Mathematics, Computer Science, Chemistry and Physics.
5. Any issue arises due to opting wrong subjects will be student's responsibility. Office will not check the opted subjects. Students may check their previous marksheets/admit card for previously opted subjects.
6. Students must choose 3 different preferences in Option Form, so that allotment will be done correctly.
7. Students shall inform other students to fill this form timely, without Fail.
