

Summary of recommendations of Academic Planning Committee 2018-19

1. Papers in AECC / GE / DSE / HDSEC / SEC shall be opened in a course subject to following -
 - Availability of Teachers (as per Sanctioned Strength of Dept.)
 - Available Infrastructure in concerned paper
 - Consent of the teachers of the course
2. Regarding DSE / HDSEC papers, following is recommended
 - Wherever students are required to study 1 paper from a group/list of papers, 2 papers should be opened; Similarly, wherever students are required to study 2 papers from a group/list of papers, 3 papers should be opened.

General principle – Students should be given one extra option paper in every group/list/bunch of option papers.
 - Minimum number of students for each DSE / HDSEC paper should be preferably 15 students.
3. Minimum group size for GE paper shall be 25 students. Maximum group size shall be 60 students
4. Size of Tutorial group (for Honours and Pass courses) shall be 10 students. Next Tutorial group should be formed when remaining students are more than 4 in number.
5. Size of Practical group (for Honours courses) shall be 12 students. Size of Practical group (for Pass/General courses) shall be 15 students. Next Practical group should be formed when remaining students are more than 5 in number.
6. Only 1 paper should be opened for SEC in each discipline in a course
7. Regarding SEC paper in B.A. Programme –
 - In 3rd and 4th semester – English, Hindi, OMSP and Computer Science papers shall be offered.
 - In 5th and 6th semester – History, Political Science, Economics and Mathematics papers shall be offered.
8. Regarding SEC paper in B.Sc. Mathematical Science –
 - In 3rd and 4th semester – Mathematics papers shall be offered.
 - In 5th and 6th semester – Mathematics papers shall be offered.
9. Regarding SEC paper in B.Sc. Physical Science –
 - In 3rd and 4th semester – Physics papers shall be offered.
 - In 5th and 6th semester – Computer Science and Chemistry papers shall be offered.



10. Committee discussed option of opening 5th Discipline paper (Sanskrit / Statistics / Operational Research) in B.A. program along with Mathematics paper.
