

The college student union election for the year 2019-20 is scheduled to be held on 12th September, 2019.

The election will held for the following posts-

- (i) President
- (ii) General Secretary
- (iii) Secretary - Women Development
- (iv) Secretary - Social Welfare Secretary
- (v) Vice-President
- (vi) Joint-Secretary

Essential requirements to contest election

- (i) He/She should have a minimum percentage of 60% marks in aggregate in the preceding academic year, and no academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
- (ii) He/She should have a minimum percentage of 75% attendance in the preceding academic year. For first year students the attendance attained till 31st of August, 2019, would be considered & a minimum percentage of 75% attendance is mandatory.
- (iii) He/She should be less than 22 years of age on 16th Aug, 2019.
- (iv) He/She should not be convicted of a criminal offence including moral turpitude.
- (v) He/She should not be found guilty by the College for any of the following acts of gross indiscipline:
 - a. Physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any person within the college;
 - b. Violation of the status, dignity and honour of women, and students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes
 - c. Willful destruction of institutional property
 - d. Causing disruption in any manner of the academic and administrative functioning of the college
- (vi) Elected office-bearer(s) of previous years are not entitled to hold the any office twice.
