Under the Aegis of IQAC, a Computer training workshop titled: **“Quality Enhancement in Basic Computers - Level I”**, first in the series, for the students and faculty, was organised in association with department of Computer Science and Hindi, in the college on February 8, 2016. The objective of the workshop was to provide an opportunity to the students and faculty for enhancement of their basic computer skills.

The workshop started with a talk by Mr. Upendra Bhati, CEO India Mergers, providing IT related services all over India, on **“Computer Literacy: Employability Quality Enhancer”**. The session had a very fruitful discussion on the topic itself with our enthusiastic students. Around 50-55 students participated in the talk and discussion.

Next was the hands-on session for the students on Basic Computer and Word Processing in the ICT lab, conducted by faculty of department of Computer Science. The training session was attended by around 40- 45 students mainly from B.A. (H) Hindi and B.A. Programme. The students, who seemed quite hesitant and immature in the beginning were looking quite confident and skilled at the end of the four hour lab session. Physical Sc. & Mathematical Sc. Courses, who provided personalised help to our training students.
