





**Minutes:**


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

**Minutes:**

1. All the student representatives informed that their syllabus was completed on time and there were Quizzes/ tests after completing each Unit. Assignments and reading material were given for revision. Mr Harshit informed that their syllabus was covered in a smooth pace in the beginning but hurriedly in the end days that became difficult for students to keep pace with.
2. All the student representatives were satisfied with the pattern of assessment through quizzes / tests after completion of every unit and suggested to continue with the same. The teacher in charge suggested including a paper presentation by the students on any topic related to current science once in every semester as a part of internal assessment to improve their knowledge about latest advancements in the field of science and technology. Attending lectures of invited guests and submitting a report on the same would also be included in internal assessment.
3. Students informed that the textbooks available in the library are limited in number (only 4-5 copies) and suggested to have more number of copies of text books. They informed that books for competitive exams are not available in the library.
4. In the present semester no departmental activities were held due to paucity of time. Suggestions were invited for holding academic as well as extracurricular activities from the students. The teacher informed that the department would organize an industrial trip in the month of January and BSc Physical Science Annual festival in collaboration with department of Physics, Computer science and Biology tentatively in March 2020. Besides this, a lecture series would also be organized in March. An excursion trip may also be organized towards the end of the semester.

#### MINUTES:

1. Members discussed about the coverage of syllabus till date and the availability of reading material in the library. Students informed that more than 60 % of syllabus has been covered till date and books available in the library covers almost entire syllabus except for SEC paper. Students informed that they have been provided notes by the teacher for SEC paper.
2. Members also discussed the scope of improving academic performance of students. the following suggestions from the students looked promising if implemented.
  - a) Each student to prepare notes on a small topic assigned by the teacher and present it orally in the class.
  - b) There should be more of power point presentation /video/graphic content in the lectures delivered by the faculty.
  - c) Every semester, one class may be devoted to an informal interaction on any topic of interest.
  - d) One presentation by each student on any topic other than their curriculum between lectures to have a grip over the language and articulation.
  - e) Faculty must include activities related to curriculum between lectures to hold interest of students.
  - f) There should be short and quick assessments for marking instead of assignments.
3. Faculty members took the suggestions constructively and decided to implement them as far as possible and also monitor the performance thereafter.
4. Final year student representative expressed their discomfort with the time table which they wish to be compressed as far as possible so that they can devote time to their coaching classes/self study for upcoming entrance examinations.
