

National Voters' Day celebrated by Maharaja Agrasen College

On 25 January 2022, Maharaja Agrasen College celebrated the 12th edition of National Voters' Day with great enthusiasm and joy. The event was organized by the ECA Committee of the college and was conducted in the hybrid mode, i.e., both online and offline.
