Code of conduct for Candidates \square

Following shall lead to disqualification from contesting the election:

- 1.No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
- 2. Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programs, past record and work. I Candidates shall refrain from criticism of aspects not connected with the public activities of the other candidates.
- 3. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes.
- 4. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting, all activities which are considered to be "corrupt practices" and offences, such as
 - bribing of voters,
 - intimidation of voters,
 - impersonation of voters,
 - canvassing or the use of propaganda near (min distance of 10 meter) polling stations,
 - Arranging transport and conveyance for voters to and fro from college.
- 5.No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlets, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing.
- 6. Candidates shall use hand-made posters for the purpose of canvassing, provided that such hand-made posters are procured within the expenditure limit set out.
- 8. No candidate is permitted to carry out processions, or public meetings, or in any way

canvass or distribute propaganda outside the college campus. I

- 9.No candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the college campus. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any defacing of college property.
- 10. During the election period the candidates may do canvassing, hold public meetings, provided that such public meetings do not, in any manner, disturb the classes and other academic and co-curricular activities of the college.

Such public meeting may not be held without the prior written permission of the college authority.

- 11. Candidates will not enter in any "Class in Progress" for canvassing under any circumstances. This will make the candidate liable to be disqualification of his/her candidature []
- 13. No one without a valid College Identity should be involved in canvassing by any candidate.
- 14. On the day of polling, student groups / societies and Candidates will

 - (ii) not serve or distribute any eatables, or other solid and liquid consumables (except water) on polling day.
- 15. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid pass / letter of authority from the election committee or from the college authorities shall enter the polling booths.
- 17. No Candidate without permission from the college authorities shall create / use online

media / medium which has college logo for canvassing.

- 18. If the candidates have any specific complaint or problem regarding the conduct of the elections they may bring the same to the notice of the Election Committee Member or College Authorities.
