

Code of conduct for Candidates □

Following shall lead to disqualification from contesting the election:

1.No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.

2.Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programs, past record and work. □ Candidates shall refrain from criticism of aspects not connected with the public activities of the other candidates.

3.There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. □

4.All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting, all activities which are considered to be “corrupt practices” and offences, such as

- bribing of voters,
- intimidation of voters,
- impersonation of voters,
- canvassing or the use of propaganda near (min distance of 10 meter) polling stations,
- Arranging transport and conveyance for voters to and fro from college.

5.No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlets, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing.

6.Candidates shall use hand-made posters for the purpose of canvassing, provided that such hand-made posters are procured within the expenditure limit set out. □

7.Candidates shall use hand-made posters at certain places in the campus, which shall be notified in advance by the election committee. □

8.No candidate is permitted to carry out processions, or public meetings, or in any way

canvass or distribute propaganda outside the college campus. □

9.No candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the college campus. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any defacing of college property. □

10. During the election period the candidates may do canvassing, hold public meetings, provided that such public meetings do not, in any manner, disturb the classes and other academic and co-curricular activities of the college.

Such public meeting may not be held without the prior written permission of the college authority.

11. Candidates will not enter in any “Class in Progress” for canvassing under any circumstances. This will make the candidate liable to be disqualification of his/her candidature □

12. The use of loudspeakers, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing is prohibited. □

13. No one without a valid College Identity should be involved in canvassing by any candidate.

14. On the day of polling, student groups / societies and Candidates will –

(i) co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subjected to any annoyance or obstruction; □

(ii) not serve or distribute any eatables, or other solid and liquid consumables (except water) on polling day.

15. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid pass / letter of authority from the election committee or from the college authorities shall enter the polling booths. □

16. No one without a valid college identity card / letter of authority from the election committee or from the college authorities shall enter the “restricted entry areas of the college” (like hostel, admin office). □

17. No Candidate without permission from the college authorities shall create / use online

media / medium which has college logo for canvassing.

18. If the candidates have any specific complaint or problem regarding the conduct of the elections they may bring the same to the notice of the Election Committee Member or College Authorities.

19. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area within 24 hours of the conclusion of polling. □

20. Any contravention of any of the above recommendations may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his/her candidature, or his/her elected post, as the case may be. □

7. All college and university dues (fees, examination fee or any other due as per university rules) are paid up-to-date.
8. During the entire election duration, during canvassing, by me or by my supporting peers, I will not deface any part of the college premise, neighbourhood residential apartments with printed posters, any other publicity materials or slogan writings.
9. During the entire election duration and even after the elections, I will not indulge in any type of unlawful activities like intimidation, threatening, shouting, fighting with other candidates and peers.
10. I do not attract any disqualifications as per the details / conditions specified in the college prospectus.
11. If any information furnished by me is found to be wrong, false or concealed, my candidature will be disqualified due to nomination errors.
12. If any information furnished by me is found to be wrong, false or concealed, post election, my election will be canceled automatically.
13. Candidates might be disqualified due to errors in filing this nomination paper. Leaving columns blanks and not furnishing complete information may render nomination invalid.
14. I will not question the lawful cancellation of my nomination paper.
