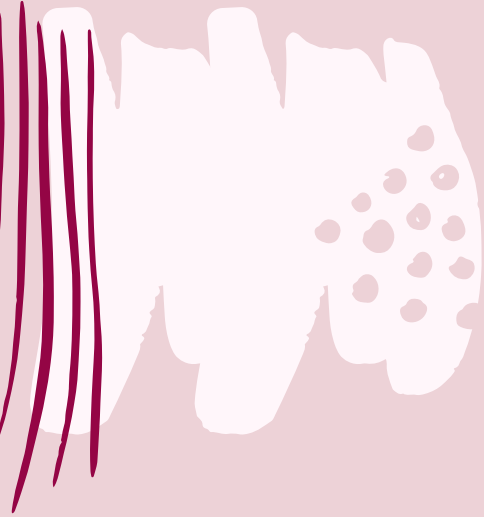

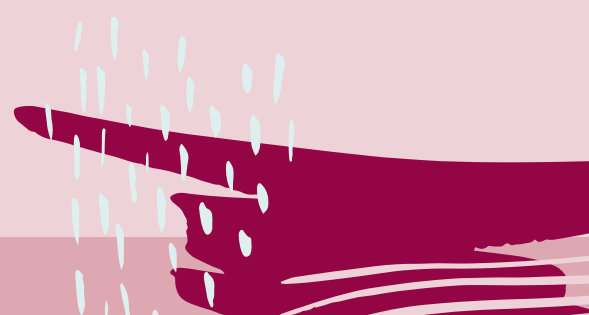

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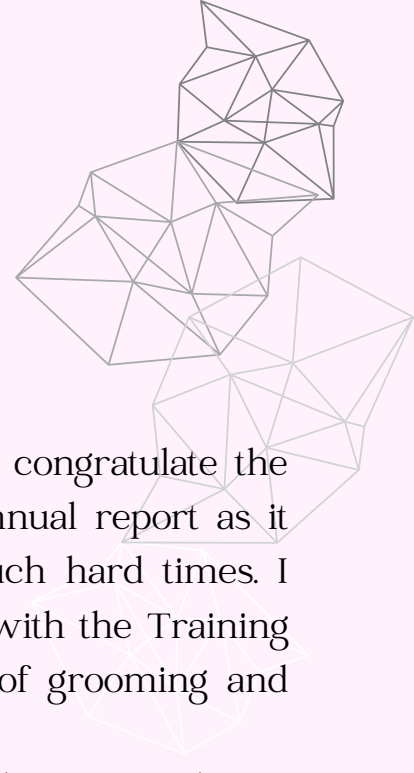
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FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

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Our Team

The cell aims at making available quality placements opportunities for the students of the college. It acts as an interface between students and various recruiters which come to the college for the placements.

The cell maintains constant contact with the students through its Instagram and LinkedIn account respectively. The cell sends regular emails to the students notifying them about the companies that would be visiting and the training programs being held, thereby encouraging them to apply for the recruitment procedure and training programme.

Various measures are taken in order to hone the skill set of the team and various informative sessions are held in order to increase the team coordination. The cell is therefore divided into four subheads and students are given roles which change on a fortnightly basis, which in turn helps in the smooth flow of operations inside the team along with the overall development of the participants.

PLACEMENTS



The Training and Placement Cell of Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi, conducted a placement drive in collaboration with WIPRO on the 10th of

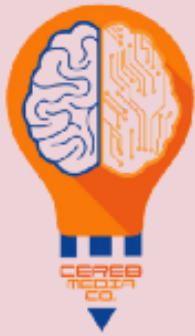

The session then concluded with a vote of thanks.



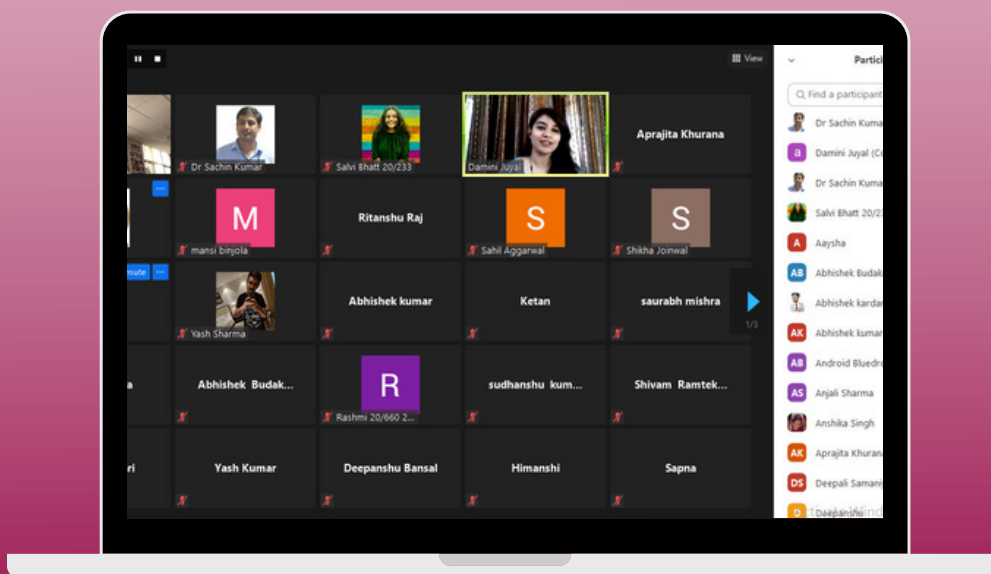
COMMUNICATION SKILLS

The session then concluded with a vote of thanks.

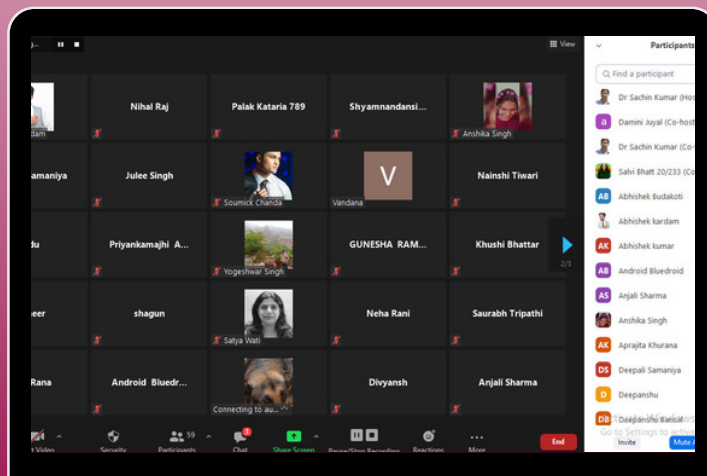


PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS

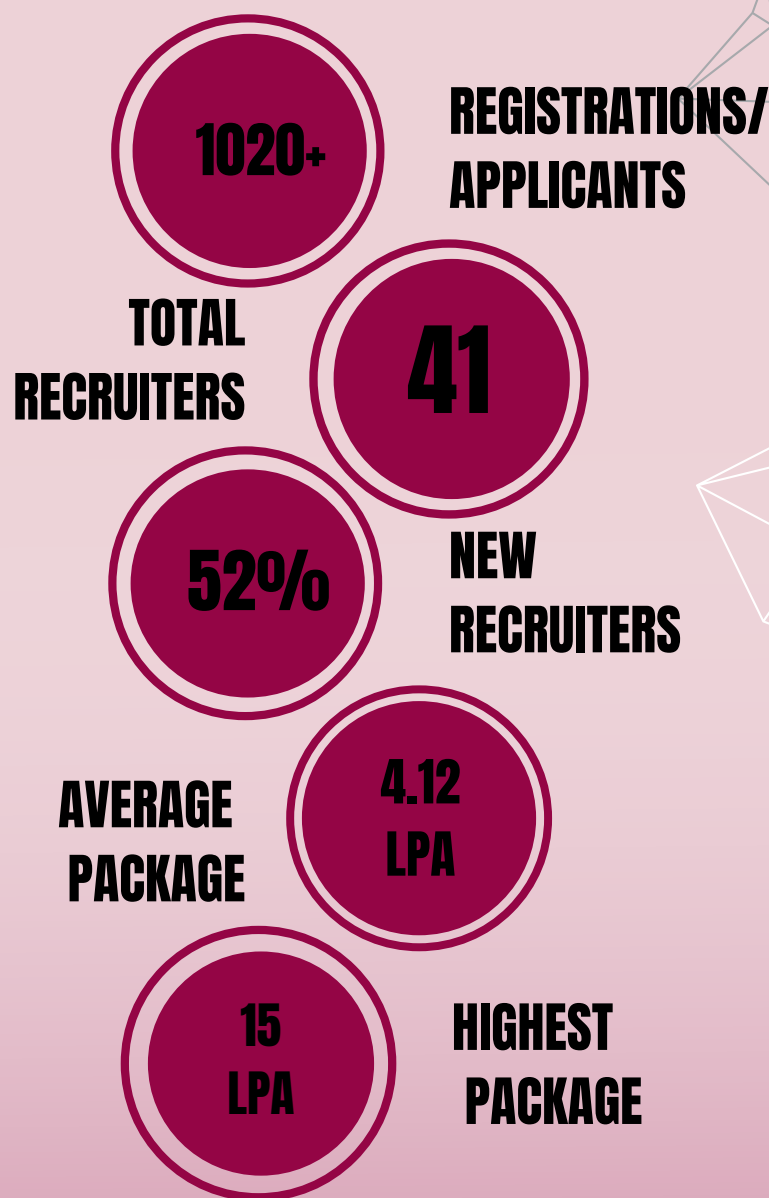
